Lacemaker forced to extreme rigor, I also find balance in a more open creative process.

Starting from my job, I divert his technique, enriched with weaving and embroidery to produce artworks of soul.
Work form as the only guide I express, in a state of letting go, an artistic universe combined with these 3 skills. Far from a ideal graphic lace, the pieces are revealed wire and automatic writing of the work by hand. Their contemplation shows a search of destructuring, of abolition of all hierarchy of assembly and balance.

Neither programming and anticipating anything, my hands express themselves in complete freedom, without a conscious filter other than 3D. I like to think that I fill the space, right in front of me, at the precise moment I am shaping. I act with complete confidence in the gesture that I have mastered. I learn, at the same time, to know and my vision and my thought, thus conforming myself without calculation to the thought of Stendhal: "We see things as our heads painted, we must therefore know this head".
